
Add the following statements to the First Aid for IF SWALLOWED:

"Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."

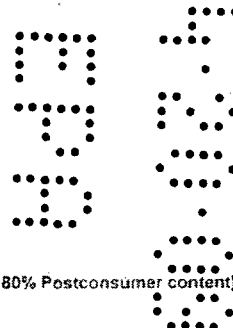
Submit two copies of the finished label before the product is released for shipment under this revised label.

Do not treat nursing puppies or kittens. Do not use on puppies under 11 weeks of age and on kittens under 6 months of age. Consult a veterinarian before treating pregnant, nursing, sick, aged, debilitated, or medicated dogs [or cats]. Sensitivities may occur after using any pesticide product on pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe pet with mild soap or a non-pesticidal shampoo and rinse with large quantities of water. If signs continue consult a veterinarian immediately. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

The dual synergistic pyrethrins provide immediate killing of fleas and ticks on the pet. Pyriproxyfen, in this special formulation*, is absorbed onto, and sticks tightly to hair and skin, even after complete rinsing. This insect growth regulator (a synthetic flea hormone) sterilizes all fleas that jump onto the pet (even new fleas before they start laying eggs) and therefore kills all flea eggs. This action persists for 1 month and breaks the flea's life cycle by preventing the development of new fleas in the pet's environment and the build-up of reinfestation pressure. Shake well before using. Wet the pet thoroughly with warm water. Apply product onto its back at the rate of approximately 1 tablespoonful for each 5lb. bodyweight (7.5g per kg) for dogs and puppies and 1¼ tablespoonful (8.5g per kg) for cats and kittens. Massage well into the skin to obtain good lathering over the entire body. Allow lather to remain in contact for at least 10 minutes then rinse off. Allow pet to air dry or blow dry. To maintain effective flea life cycle control (through IGR flea egg killing) repeat treatment at least once every month. Under conditions of flea reinfestation pressure from the environment, repeat treatment when new parasites are seen on the pet, but not more frequently than once weekly on dogs and twice monthly on cats.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL DIRECTIONS

STORAGE: Store in closed container in a cool dry area.

DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Call you local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
