

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READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USING USE ONLY ON DOGS PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS CAUTION

HAZARDS TO HUMANS: This collar is intended for use as an insecticide generator only on pet animals. Do not allow children to handle or play with this collar. May cause contact sensitization following repeated contact with skin in susceptible individuals. Avoid repeated contact with skin. If sensitization reactions result, contact a physician. Wash hands with soap and water after handling.

HAZARDS TO ANIMALS: Oo not apply to pupples under 10-weeks-old. Do not use other challesterase inhibiting pesticides, drugs or chemicals on dog while collar is worn. Consult a veterinarian before using on debilitated, aged, medicated, pregnant or nursing animals. Some pets may be sensitive to ingredients in this product. If pet shows adverse effects, remove collar, bathe pet with a non-pesticidal shampoo and consult a veterinarian if reaction persists or becomes more severe.

Note to Physicians/Veterinarians: This product contains a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine suifate and 2-PAM are antiocal only if signs of cholinesterase inhibition are present.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE It is a violation of Federal Law to use this collar in a manner inconsistent with its labelling. The two active ingredients in this collar have different and comprementary functions. The IGR (synthetic flea hormone), pynproxyfen (Nylar*), sterilizes all fleas that jump onto the pat (even new fleas before they start taying eggs) and kills all flea eggs. Pyriproxyfen is continuously released from the collar, spreads over the pet in the natural oils of the haircoat and skin and adheres tightly to hair and skin to provide 10 months of continuous flea ovisteriant efficacy. This breaks the flea's life cycle by preventing the development of new fleas in the pet's environment that would normally reinfest the pet. This ovicidal activity of pyriproxyfen starts immediately, reaches 100% effectiveness within 3-4 days and continues at 100% effectiveness as long as the collar is worn (up to 300 days). The second active, diazrinon, also spreads over the pet in the oil of its skin and haircoat where it kills any existing fleas and ticks on the pet writin 2 days. Diazrinon continues to kill any new fleas and ticks that may climb onto the pet for 150 days. The collar and its active ingredients in the pet's haircoat are not affected by normal wettergor by bathing. It is recommended that this collar should be replaced once a year, preferably before the beginning of the flea season.

APPLICATION: Place collar around the pet's neck, adjust for proper fit and buckle in place. Cut off and dispose of excess length. The collar must be worn tightly enough to contact skin, yet one finger can be placed between collar and pet's neck. If the collar is worn too tightly, it may produce neck initiation.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL STORAGE: Store in a cool dry place.

DISPOSAL. Do not reuse empty pouch or box. Wrap pouch and put in trash collection. When discarding cut off end and used collar, wrap in newspaper and place in trash collection.
