d. The Statement Of Practical Treatment must read as follows:

"IF ON SKIN: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice."

"IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice."

Copies of the acute toxicity and companion animal safety reviews are enclosed for your records.

Submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed label before you release the product for shipment.

If the final printed labeling is not received prior to shipment of this product, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these requirements.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS: Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash exposed skin with soap and water after using.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If in Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. If on skin. Wash with plenty of soap and water. Consult a physician If irritation persists.

HAZARDS TO ANIMALS: Do not treat kittens less than one month. Consult a veterinarian before treating pregnant, nursing, sick, aged debilitated or medicated cats. Sensitivities may occur after using any pesticide product on pests. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe pet with mild soap or a non-pesticidal shampoo and rinse with large quantities of water. If signs continue consult a veterinarian immediately.

DIRECTION FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling. Pyriproxyfen (Nylar®) IGR sterilizes all fleas and (kills) their eggs for up to 3 months. This action breaks the flea life cycle and prevents the development of new fleas in the pet's environment that might reinfest the pet. Remove the cap of the pipette. Part the hair between the shoulder blades. Squeeze the pipette firmly to empty the entire contents directly on the skin at the base of the neck. Care should be taken in keeping the pipette in contact with the skin. Avoid contact with treated area until dry. Reapply every three months. Efficacy is not reduced by bathing, water immersion, or exposure to sun light.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area.

DISPOSAL: Wrap empty container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
