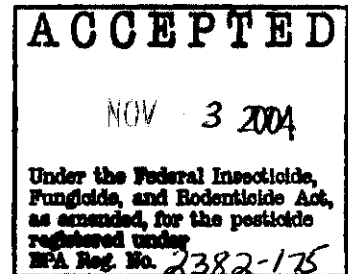

If In Eyes ° Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
 ° Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eyes.
 ° Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If On Skin or Clothing ° Take off contaminated clothing.
 ° Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
 ° Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If Swallowed ° Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
 ° Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
 ° Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor.
 ° Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If Inhaled ° Move person to fresh air.
 ° If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.
 ° Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Remove excess dirt and wax, then place recommended dose in each ear. Reapply every day for 7 to 10 days.

INDICATIONS: Ear mites normally cause a dry, dark brown waxy exudate with crusts in the ears of dogs and cats. Mites are easily observed by placing some of the ear wax on a dark surface and watching closely for moving white specks. Do not injure the delicate tissue of the ear. Inflamed, watery or blocked ear canals indicate a more serious condition which requires services of a veterinarian.

BODY WEIGHT AND DOSE

1 to 15 lbs.	3 to 5 drops
15 to 30 lbs.	5 to 10 drops
30lbs. and over	10 to 15 drops

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
