While dipping, lightly sponge inside of ears for ear mite control. Do not submerge the animals nose, mouth or eyes. Let the animal drip-dry. **DO NOT RINSE OFF.** Do not reapply product for 7 days. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 12 weeks of age.
