Sprinkle along underside of furniture. Do not use on exposed fabric: may cause staining. Remove bag from vacuum cleaner. Wrap securely in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Test hidden surface of upholstery before cleaning. If texture or color is affected, do not use. Clean carpet AFTER using this product. Treat pets with a registered flea and tick control powder prior to re-entry into treated area.

Do not use on surfaces that come into direct contact with food. For severe infestations apply this product behind cabinets and walls, in crawl spaces, and in attics at a rate of 16 ounces per 1000 square feet of surface area.
