Dear Mr Dyer:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Revise the Precautionary Statements as follows:
 - a. Delete "Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist."
 - b. Replace "Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through the skin or inhaled" with "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin."
 - c. Move "Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs. Do not spray plants used for food or feed." to the Directions for Use.
- 2. Revise the front panel as follows:
 - a. Replace "Evercide Intermediate 2575" with "Evercide Intermediate 2527"

- b. Replace "that carry and transmit lyme disease" with "that may carry and transmit lyme disease".
- 3. Since the product contains more than 10% petroleum distillate, in the If Swallowed first aid statement, replace "Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow" with "Do not give any liquid to the person."
- 4. Under Environmental Hazards delete the statement, "For terrestrial uses do not apply directly etc". The statement "Do not apply to any body of water" is appropriate for a residential use product except add the word directly to the statement i.e., "Do not apply directly to any body of water".

Note, base on the inhalation acute toxicity of the product (Tox Category IV), you are not required to have an If inhaled first aid statement. You may delete this statement if you wish. If you have any questions regarding this action, please contact BeWanda Alexander of my team at (703) 305-7460.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to fish and other aquatic animals. Drift from treated areas may be hazardous to organisms in adjacent aquatic sites. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not apply to any body of water. Do not contaminate water by disposal of equipment washwaters or rinsate.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

DIRECTION FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

LAWN FLEA AND TICK CONTROL: To kill fleas and ticks harboring in lawns and back yards use this concentrate in a hose-end sprayer. Place required amount of concentrate in sprayer jar (see chart below) and fill with water to the recommended level. Mix well. Attach sprayer to hose and spray as recommended. For best results, lawn should be moved a day or two before spraying. Spray using a slow, even sweeping motion, being sure to cover the entire lawn surface where the pets will normally frequent. Spray under ornamentals or trees, but avoid soaking young or flowering plants. Repeat treatments may be necessary at 7 to 14 day intervals. Kills on contact the <u>Ixodes dammini</u> tick (deer tick) which may transmit Lyme disease. Also kills foraging fire ants upon direct contact. A registered fire ant mound treatment should also be used in conjunction with this product.

Keep pets and children out of the treated area until after the spray has dried. Do not spray animals. Dogs, cats, their kennel or bedding area should also be treated with a registered flea and tick control product in conjunction with this application.

FOR OUTDOOR PESTS: Mix concentrate in a compressed air sprayer or watering can at a rate of two (2) fluid ounces per one (1) gallon of water to control on contact ants, cockroaches (including German and Asian cockroaches), crickets, palmetto bugs, sowbugs, spiders, and ticks. Use at the rate of one (1) gallon (diluted spray) per 1,000 square feet to outside surfaces of buildings, porches, patios, garages and other areas where these pests have been seen or are found. Do not allow spray to contact ornamental plants or shrubs because of possible injury.

DIRECTIONS OF USE (CONTINUED)

BUILDING PERIMETER TREATMENT: To help prevent infestations of buildings by ants, centipedes, crickets, sowbugs, and spiders, treat a 12 to 18 inch band of soil or other substrate adjacent to buildings and the building foundation to a height of 2 to 3 feet where these pests are active and may find entrance. Use sixteen (16) fluid ounces of concentrate per gallon of water and apply as a coarse wet spray at the rate of (1) gallon per 1,000 square feet.

HOSE END SPRAYER INSTRUCTIONS:

STEP #1: Turn water control knob on hose spray to the OFF position.

FIGURE/PICTURE #1

STEP #2: Grasp handle and shake thoroughly, turning bottle as you shake.

FIGURE/PICTURE #2

STEP #3: Connect hose to spray nozzle.

FIGURE/PICTURE #3

STEP #4: Bend safety tab down and turn control to "water".

FIGURE/PICTURE #4

STEP #5: Slowly turn on water supply until it reaches a moderate flow.

FIGURE/PICTURE #5

STEP #5: Point nozzle toward lawn, turn water control knob to "ON" position.

FIGURE/PICTURE #6

Note: This product will automatically mix with water. Slowly sweep the area to be treated. Apply evenly using a back and forth motion. Hold bottle level and always move at a steady pace, spraying directly on insects whenever possible. Average water pressure will empty the bottle in approximately 5 minutes. One bottle is enough to treat up to 11,200 sq. ft. Repeat treatment when needed to maintain effectiveness.

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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets.
