It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ZEMA IGR Premise Spray kills fleas and ticks. This product contains a combination of ingredients that kills both adult and pre-adult fleas, and even kills fleas before they grow up to bite. NYLAR®, an ingredient in the flea spray, continues to kill fleas for 120 days (4 months) by preventing their development into the adult biting stage. It reaches fleas hidden in carpets, rugs, drapes, upholstery, pet bedding, and floor cracks. Prevents reinfestation and buildup of fleas in the home. One treatment with this spray gives continuous flea protection for 120 days. Leaves no objectionable or sticky mess and when used as directed, does not stain furnishings.

PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

Do not enter or allow others to enter the treated area until the sprays have dried.
