In accordance with 40 CFR 152.46, Virbac AH, Inc. submits herewith an application for pesticide notification for subject product. This submission allows for labeling changes per PR Notice 2007-4 to the side/back panel of the label. The labeling changes are noted below and clearly marked on the revised product label (see attachment).

"Notification of label change per PR Notice 2007-4. This notification is consistent with the guidance in PR Notice 2007-4 and the requirements of EPA's regulations at 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156. No other changes have been made to the labeling or the Confidential Statement of Formula for this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if the amended label is not consistent with the requirements of 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA."

Revisions to side/back panel of the label in the "Storage and Disposal" section:

Added: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed, by storage and disposal.

Added: Pesticide before Storage

Replace "Disposal" statement with the following:

 Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. If Empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling, if available.

- If Partly Filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place any unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain."

This product is in compliance with 40 CFR 156.140(a)(4) as the lot number is adhered to the product. This product is exempt from 40 CFR 156.144 through 156.156 due to the product's residential/household use. Additionally, this product is not a dilutable (liquid or solid) formulation.



IGR Total Release Fogger contains a combination of three insecticides that stops the flea life cycle in three ways and controls other insects. The first insecticide is pyriproxyfen (NYLAR®), an insect growth regulator that will not allow the flea to reproduce thereby providing long term control. The second insecticide is the botanical, Pyrethrin, which provides effective quick kill of insects upon direct contact and an added benefit of flushing the insects from their hiding place to aid in a more complete control. Permethrin, the third active insecticide, provides activity until the NYLAR® takes effect.

IGR Total Release Fogger contains a combination of ingredients that kill both adult and hatching fleas. NYLAR®, the Insect Growth Regulator in this fogger continues to kill hatching fleas for 7 months by preventing their development into adults. The fogger reaches fleas (and other insects) hidden in carpets, rugs, drapes, upholstery, pet bedding, floor cracks and open cabinets. Occasionally adult fleas may be present in treated areas when reintroduced from infested animals.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE


It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Does not control bed bugs. (bold)

For use only when building has been vacated by human beings and pets. Ventilate treated area for 30 minutes before re-entry. For best results treat all infested areas. One fogger will treat a room up to 27 feet by 27 feet with an 8 foot ceiling. Use additional units for remote rooms or where the free flow of fog is not assured.

To Use This Product Correctly (bold): DO NOT use more than one fogger per room.




DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Use of a fogger in an enclosed space may cause the product to explode, resulting in injury to people or damage to property.



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Do not use in rooms 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.).



Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

Before You Fog (bold): Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces or wash them before use.




Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close outside doors and windows. Remove pets and birds but leave pets bedding as this is a primary hiding place for fleas and must be treated for best results. No need to discard pet bedding after treatment. Cover or remove fish tanks and bowls. Leave rugs, drapes and upholstered furniture in place. This product will not harm furniture when used as directed. Open interior closet doors and cabinets or areas to be treated. Cover waxed furniture and wood floors in the immediate area surrounding the fogger.

For more effective control of storage pests and cockroaches open all cupboard doors and drawers for better penetration of fog. Remove all infested foodstuffs and dispose of in outdoor trash.

For flea and tick control, thoroughly vacuum all carpeting, upholstered furniture, along baseboards, under furniture and in closets. Put vacuum bag into a sack and dispose of in outside trash. Mop all hard floor surfaces.

READ ALL DIRECTIONS AND CAUTIONS BEFORE USING: TO START FOGGING, SHAKE FOGGER WELL BEFORE USING. Hold can at arms length with top of can pointing away from the face and eyes. Push down on finger pad until it locks. This will start fogging action. Set canister in an upright position on a table, stand, etc. (up to 30" in height in the center of the area) and place several thickness of newspaper under the canister to prevent marring of the surface. Treat the whole dwelling using multiple units in homes with more than one level and numerous rooms. Vacate the treated house, individual apartment unit, or other structure immediately.

Page 4 of 5 August 15, 2011 DO NOT RE-ENTER THE BUILDING FOR TWO HOURS. Airing Out:



Wait two (2) hours after application, then open windows, vents and doors for two hours. If an odor is still detected, additional ventilation is required.

If additional units are used for remote rooms or where free flow of fog is not assured, increase airing-out time accordingly.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, feed, by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool dry place inaccessible to children and away from heat and open flame. Store away from food and pet food.

Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!

If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions.
