- Correct spelling of "phosphorate" to phosphorothicate in ingredient statement.
- Please supply the upper and lower certified limits on all ingredients. We have enclosed a current Confidential Statement of Formula form for your convenience.
- 3. Consult Section 162.10(a)(2) of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) for type size, prominence, and legibility of words and statements on final printed labels. Enclosed is a copy of that part of the CFR.
- 4. Your st_rage and disposal statements should read as follows:
