

MOUND TREATMENT: Dust area 2 feet wide around base of mound. Use 1 cup per mound. Tear down mound onto treated area and dust thoroughly all exposed soil. Treat when insects appear. Repeat treatment in 10 days to 2 weeks if surviving colonies are found.


