

Place baits in locations not accessible to children, pets, and domestic animals, or in tamper-proof bait boxes. If swallowed by humans, domestic animals, or pets, this material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. In such case, intravenous and oral administration of Vitamin K, combined with blood transfusions are indicated as in the case of hemorrhage caused by overdoses of bishydroxycoumarin. In case of ingestion, call a physician.

This rodenticide contains Warfarin, an anticoagulant chemical that reduces the clotting ability of the blood and, upon repeated feedings, causes fatal hemorrhage in rats and mice. It also contains an antibacterial agent which inhibits bacteria that produce Vitamin K, an antidote for Warfarin. It thereby increases effectiveness against hard-to-kill rats and mice and gives better and more thorough control.
