The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted subject to the comments reflected on the enclosed sheet. A copy of your proposed labeling stamped "ACCEPTED WITH COMMENTS" is enclosed.

WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

Based on your certification, the Agency has accepted the labeling changes that are necessary to comply with the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) labeling requirements of 40 CFR part 156, subpart K, described in PR Notices 93-7 and 93-11. Any other labeling changes submitted in connection with this amendment application but not directly related to compliance with the WPS have not been reviewed or accepted by the Agency. If you wish to make such changes, you must submit a separate amendment application proposing them. If your product is currently suspended, the acceptance of this labeling amendment does not affect the suspension in any way.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT Carbaryl is an M-Methyl Carbanate Insecticide.

If on Skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and water.

If Swallowed: Induce vomiting by drinking 1 or 2 glasses of water and touching back of throat with finger or blunt object. Call a physician or poison control center immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If in Eyes: Flush with plenty of water and get medical attention.

HOTE TO PHYSICIAE: Carbaryl is a moderate.

MOTE TO PHYSICIAM: Carbaryl is a moderate, reversible, cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. Do not use 2-PAM, opiates or cholinesterase-inhibiting drugs.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic and estuarine invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water or areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark, except for rice uses. Discharge from rice fields may kill aquatic and estuarine invertebrates. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Carbaryl is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on crops. Protective information may be obtained from your Cooperative Agricultural Extension Service.

IMPORTANT PRE-HARVEST AND GRAZING USE INFORMATION

Tolerances established under the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act permit the sale of crops bearing probable SEVIN residues when SEVIN is used in accordance with label directions. If SEVIN insecticide is used in accordance with label directions, these crops including bean vines, carrot tops, pea vines, sugar beet tops, corn forage and cotton forage, may be grazed or harvested for use as feed for dairy and meat animals without resulting in residues in milk or meat in excess of established tolerances.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the portection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protective equipment (PPE), and restricted-entry interval. The requirements in this box apply to uses of this product that are covered by the Worker Protection Standard. Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval (REI) of 12 hours. PPE required for early entry to treated areas that is permitted under the Worker Protection Standard and that involves contact with anything that has been treated, such as plants, soil, or water, is: coveralls, waterproof gloves and shoes plus socks.

Broadcast application may be made with either ground equipment or aircraft, under conventional, minimal and no-till practices. Treatments may be repeated as necessary. Where a range of rates is provided, use lower rates for light infestation, early instars or when foliage is not too dense; use higher rates for moderate to heavy

infestation, advanced instars or when foliage is thick. For best results on lawn and turf, cut lawn, remove clippings and water thoroughly before treatment. Dosages from 20 to 48 pounds of bait per acre will control cutworms, armyworms, field crickets, house crickets, mole crickets, darkling beetles, grasshoppers, sowbugs and ants.
