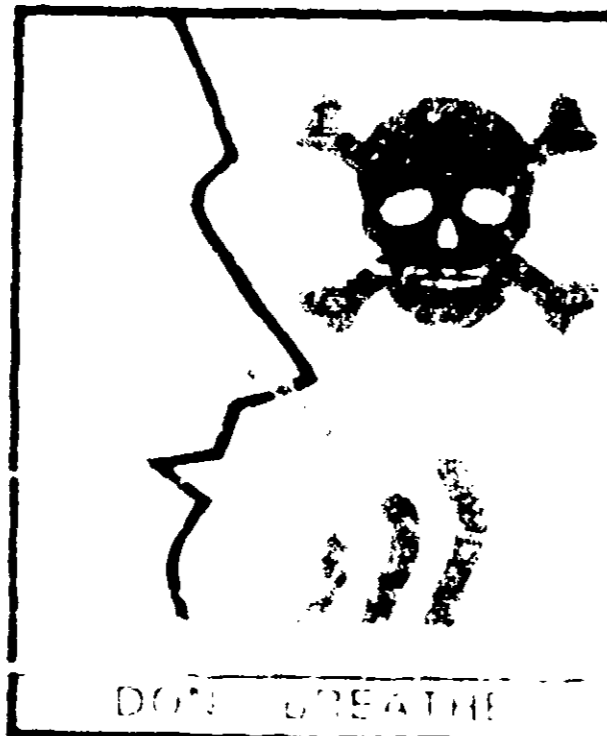
Even in small amounts!

Poisonous if touched by hands or spilled or splashed on skin, in eyes, or on clothes (liquid goes through clothes)



DON'T BREATHE

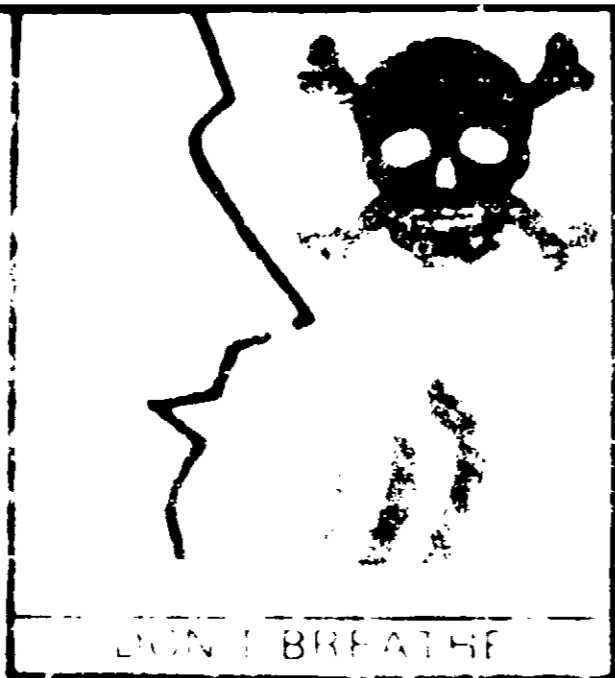
POISONOUS IF BREATHED

Poisonous if vapor or mists from sprays are breathed. Vapors are not visible. Never work with parathion or in parathion or in parathion treated areas without protective clothing and equipment.

WORK SAFETY RULES

USE ONLY WHEN WEARING THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT 1) Wear waterproof pants, coat, hat, rubber boots or rubber overalls. 2) Wear safety goggles. 3) Wear mask or respirator approved by the U.S. Bureau of Mines for parathion protection. 4) Wear heavy duty natural rubber gloves.

Keep unprotected persons and children away from treated areas where there is a danger of drift.

Do not rub eyes or mouth with hands. Do not smoke. Parathion soaks into gloves, wash them with soap and water. If you feel sick, stop work and get help right away. Tell foreman or have someone call a doctor or physician, name and dose to immediately.

ALWAYS wash hands, face, neck with soap and water before smoking, eating or drinking.

AFTER WORK take a shower, wash and soap. Shower as hot as you can stand. Wash hair with shampoo. **DO NOT** drink alcohol for 24 hours.

Do not eat, drink or smoke until you have washed and changed your clothes. Do not use handkerchiefs, towels, or clothing that has been used in the treated area.

Signs and Symptoms of Poisoning: Abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, cramps, blurred vision, pinpoint pupils, sweating, salivation, weakness, dizziness, headache, loss of consciousness, difficulty breathing, and convulsions.

POSTING TREATED AREA The treated area should be posted with signs and barriers to prevent entry.

FIRST AID TREATMENT

Get help right away. Do not give anything by mouth. If possible, have person treated by a doctor. Do not give anything by mouth.

IF BREATHING IS STOPPED Get help right away. Start artificial respiration immediately.

IF SWALLOWED Get help right away. Do not give anything by mouth. If possible, have person vomit quickly. Do not give anything by mouth. Repeat by giving more water and stroke back of throat to get rid of anything left in the stomach. **Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.** Place person face down and keep quiet.

IN CASE OF SKIN CONTACT Immediately remove wet clothing and shoes. Wash skin with soap and water for at least 15 minutes.

EYE CONTACT Get help right away. Flush eyes with water for at least 15 minutes.
