DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Scatter Hopkins FLY BAIT GRITS daily, or as needed, to reduce fly population. Distribute bait from container, or with jar or can to avoid handling bait. Keep FLY BAIT GRITS in original container, tightly closed, and store in cool place.

LOAFING SHEDS, LIVESTOCK PENS, PIG PARLORS, STABLES, BROILER HOUSES: 1) se only around outside areas. Scatter FLY BAIT GRITS at the rate of 1/4 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. on ground areas where flies congregate. Ideal baiting sites are around doorways, along fence lines, soiled areas, or in alleyways of feedlots.

CAGED POULTRY AND TURKEYS ON WIRE: Scatter FLY BAIT GRITS on walkways at the rate of 1/4 lb. par 500 sq. ft. to aid in controlling houseflies. Also scatter outdoors around doorways.

DOG KENNELS AND FURBEARING ANIMAL UNITS: Scatter FLY BAIT GRITS around outside areas of dog pens, runways and other surfaces out of reach of animals. For cage units, scatter on walkways at the rate of % lo. per 500 sq. ft.

FOOD, POULTRY AND MEAT PROCESSING PLANTS: Scatter FLY BAIT GRITS at the rate of ¼ 1b. per 1,000 sq. ft. in inedible departments only. FLY BAIT GRITS may be used outside livestock pens or loadir.g and unloading docks.
