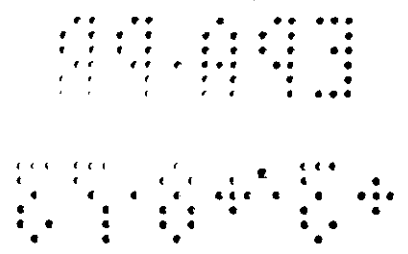

Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material is washed into the soil and grass is dry.

Apply this product only as specified on this label.

USE DIRECTIONS

To control Chinch Bugs, Sod Webworms (Lawn Moths), Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Crickets, Cutworms, Earwigs and Sowbugs (Pillbugs) apply Hopkins Lawn Granules at the rate of 200 pounds per acre. Apply uniformly to home lawns and other ornamental and recreational turf grass areas using any hand or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Treat when insects first appear. To help obtain uniform distribution apply one-half the required amount of product in one direction than apply the balance at a right angle.

Immediately after application sprinkle the turf with 1,300 gallons of water per acre so as to wash the granules into the zone of insect infestation. Consult the table below to determine amounts of Hopkins Lawn Granules and water needed to treat smaller areas. Repeat as necessary.

To control Hyperodes (Turf Grass) Weevils use twice the rate of Hopkins Lawn Granules as shown in the table below. Treat suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for best time to treat in your area.
