A non-oily lubricant has also been added to help prevent cracking and splitting of the seed in the planter box so they will flow easily and evenly.

fill the planter box approximately one-half full of seed and add half the recommended dosage. Stir with a stick or paddle until uniform coverage is observed. Add the remaining seed and chemital and thoroughly as above.

CORN (Field) - Use at the rate of 4 ounces per bushel or 7 ounces, ber 100 pounds of seed as a planter bex treatment.

PEANUTS (Shelled) - For control of Asperoillus niger and other seed and soil-borne diseases. use 2 to 4 ounces per bushel or 4 to 6 ounces per 100 pounds of seed as a planter box treatment.
