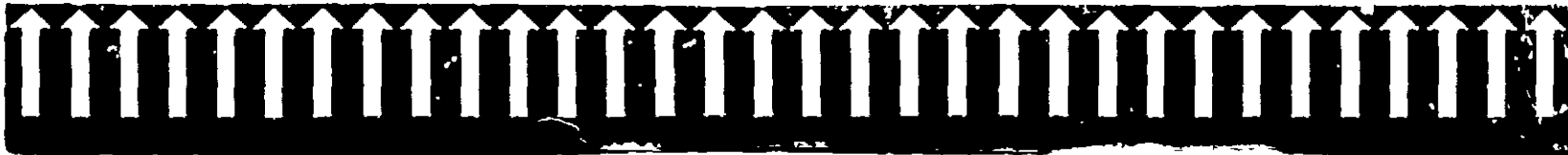

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting unless directed by physician. 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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Storage temperatures exceeding 100°F (37.8°C) are not recommended.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State, or local procedures.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or reconditioning or dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures.

NOTE: Do not allow this product to come into contact with croplands, lawns, desirable trees or plants, or to areas where their roots may extend, and, do not allow this product to contact fertilizers, pesticides or seeds.

For general weed control on non-crop areas, mix this product at a rate of 1 gallon with 7 to 15 gallons of water in a sprayer that will give uniform coverage on 1600 square feet. Add this product to water with agitation. Maintain agitation until tank has been emptied. Use spray material as soon as possible after mixing. Use coarser spray tips delivering 1 gallon per minute or higher. For small areas or spot treating, mix 8 ounces (1/2 pint or 1 cup) per 100 square feet with 1 to 1 1/2 quarts of water. For band treatment along fence lines and curbs, 8 ounces of this product will treat a 4-inch band 300 feet long. Best results are obtained if tall vegetation is mowed off and the litter removed before treatment, or when vegetation first begins to appear early in the growing season. Rain or thorough watering following treatment will speed results as this product penetrates to the root zone. Retreatments may be necessary in 6 to 12 months depending on soil type, rainfall following treatment, and weed species present.

Application equipment should be thoroughly cleaned with detergent and water to prevent corrosion. Equipment which has been used to apply this product should not be used for applying insecticides, fungicides, fertilizers or other agricultural chemicals to desirable plants as plant injury or loss may result.
