## DIRECTIONS

The following general directions are supplied by us gratuitously and are believed to be reliable, but are in no way guaranteed.

MIXING SPRAYS: Wash Ferbam into spray tank through a deep screen, or make a thick paste with a little water, then dilute it and add to spray tank while filling.

SPREADER-STICKER: The addition of Orchard

Brand Filmfasto, Genifilmo "L", or Piyaco will improve coverage on foliage which is difficult to wet.

Dosages below are based on the amount of Forbam to be used in 100 gallons of water.

## FRUIT

APPLES: For Apple Scab, use 1 to 1½ pounds. Apply in pre-bloom, calyx and early cover sprays. Reduce to ¾ pound in later cover sprays. When used in combination with sulfur, Ferbam is recommended at ½ pound, plus 3 pounds of micron-fine wettable sulfur (Orchard Brand Micro-Dritomic Sulfur). Do Not use sulfur if russeting has tender varieties such as Golden Delicious as it may contribute to fruit russeting.

For Cedar Apple Rust Diseases, keép follage and fruit covered during infection periods. Use as above, plus a special bloom spray of ½ pound.

For Black Rot (Frog-eye) (Leaf and Fruit Spot), Apple Blotch, Bitter Rot, Sooty Blotch and Fly Speck, use 1 to 1½ pounds.

CHERRIES: For Leaf Spot, use 112 pounds. Apply 4 sprays, at petal-fall, 2 and 4 weeks after petal-fall and immediately after harvest. For Brown Rot, use 1½ pounds. Apply at popcorn, full-bloom and petal-fall, and starting 2 to 3 weeks before harvest apply one or more sprays at 7 to 10 day intervals.

## OTHER CROPS

CABBAGE: For Downy Mildew In plant beds, use 1½ pounds. Make 2 to 3 applications a week starting when plants emerge. Do Not use more than 3 pounds per acre per application.

at the rate of 3 to 4 pounds per 100 gallons of water. Use the 4-pound rate if equipment and timing are not perfect. Apply 3 gallons per 100 square yards when plants are small. Increase to 6 gallons as plants are ready for transplanting. Start applications when leaves are the size of a dime or when the Mold first appears in your area. Apply twice a week to I time for transplanting.

CAMAMONALS: For D'ack Spot and Rust of Roses; Cepterla Leaf Spot and Rust of Chrysanthemuns; Snapdragon Rust and

PEARS: For Scab, use 1½ pounds. Apply in pink, calyx, first cover spray and second cover spray. For Fabraea (Leaf Blight and Fruit Spot) and Sooty Blotch, use 1 pound in the summer sprays.

PEACHES: For Peach Leaf Curl and Shot Hole (fungus), use 11/2 to 3 pounds. Apply at der

bud and 25% to 75% of full bloom. For Fusicoccum Canker (constriction) in New Jersey and Mascachusetts, use 1½ pounds. Apply before bloom (starting in early March) and after harvest as long as weather permits. Space sprays 7 to 10 days apart.

GRAPES: For Black Rot, use 2 pounds. Apply just before bloom, immediately after bloom and 2 weeks after bloom. Do Not use more than 6 lbs. per acre per application.

CRANBERRIES: For Fruit Rots, use 3 pounds. Apply at mid-bloom and repeat at 2 week intervals, for a total of 3 applications. Do Not use more than 9 pounds per acre per application.

NOTE: Do Not use on apples, pears, or grapes later than 7 days before harvest; on peaches Not later than 21 days before harvest; on cranberries Not later than 28 days after mid-bloom.

Leaf Spot; Bacterial Leaf Spot of Geraniums; Alternaria Bilght and Rust of Carnations; Leaf Spot and Botrytis Rot of Cyclamen; Botrytis Blight (tulip fire) of Tulips; Juniper Rust, and Aster, Regonia, Gardenia, Hydrangea, Ivy, and Laurel Leaf Spots—Use 1 to 1½ pounds.
