STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Call a physician or Poison Control Center in all cases of suspected poisoning.

If on skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. Separately launder contaminated clothing in HOT water and detergent before reuse.

If inhaled: Assist respiration as necessary and get medical attention.

If in eyes: Flush with clean water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Keep patient warm and quiet.

To physician: Empty stomach. Cautious gastric lavage is usually indicated. Avoid aspirator. Administration of fats or oils should be avoided. Toxaphene produces central nervous system excitation, which responds to barbituric acid derivatives. Respiratory function should be monitored. Diazepam may be preferable to barbiturate as an anticonvulsant due to reduced likelihood of respiratory depression. Consult current treatment literature.

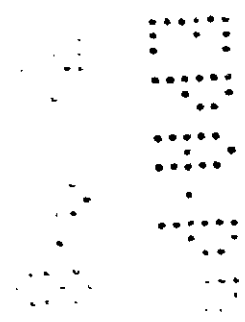
