
LICE ON BEEF CATTLE, SHEEP AND GOATS (DO NOT APPLY TO DAIRY GOATS): Spray animals thoroughly with 0.03% Lindane prepared as follows: mix 1 tablespoon HOPKINS LINDANE E.C. II to 11/2 gallons water or 1 pint to 45 gallons water. Skin and hair on sheep and goats must be thoroughly wet. Repeat as necessary.

LICE ON HOGS: Spray hogs with a solution not to exceed 0.06% Lindane prepared as follows: mix 3 tablespoons HOPKINS LINDANE E.G. If to 2 gallons water or 1 quart to 45 galions water. Repeat as necessary. Do not treat nows within 2 weeks of farrowing nor for at leas; 3 weeks thereafter.



# STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. Do not induce vomiting. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin: Remove contaminated ciothing and wash affected area with scap and wate; If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of wate; Cali a physician if irritation persists. Note to Physician: Solvent presents copiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally.

# PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. May be absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and skin contact.

Do not treat sows within 2 weeks of farrowing nor for at least 3 weeks thereafter.

Do not use on poultry.

Do not use on lactating dairy cattle or dairy goats,

Do not use a solution stronger than 1 pint mixed in 45 gallons of water on calves and other young livestock between 3 and 6 months old, and use spray form only. Applicators must wear water resistant hat; lightweight protective suit or coverails; unlined waterproof gloves (natural rubber, neoprane or polyethylene); and unlined, lightweight boots. Mixers/loaders must wear goggles or a face shield, waterproof apron and unlined waterproof gloves.

Applicators working in enclosed areas, such as crawi spaces, must wear a MSHA/NIOSH approved respirator.

LIVESTOCK SPRAY USE INSTRUCTIONS: Use a sprayer capable of maintaining a pressure of 200 to 400 psl and use 1 to 2 gallons of spray per head for cattle and proportionately less for smaller animals.

DIP USE INSTRUCTIONS: immerse infected animals at least 1/2 minute in a swim dip vat, cage vat or spray dip machine. Solution should be checked frequently at vat side to assure proper dipping strength (0.06% Lindane). Be certain animals are well watered prior to dipping to prevent them from drinking the dip solution. If oily layer forms, do not treat animals. Clean out entire vat when solution becomes filthy.

SARCOPTIC AND PSOROPTIC MANGE ON BEEF CATTLE AND HOGS: Use 0.06% Lindane prepared as follows; mix 3 tablespoons HOPKINS LINDANE E.C. II to 2 gallons water or 1 quart to 45 gallons water. Spray or dip animals thoroughly including inside of ears. Pens and shelters should be sprayed to prevent re-infection. Use two applications at 7-14 day intervals. If animals are between 3 and 6 months old and require treatment, use spray method only and apply the 0.00% solution (1 pint to 45 gallons water).
