APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

RATS: Apply one to four 4-oz. plastic packs of bait per placement. The amount of bait in this 4 oz. package is unlikely to be sufficient to kill more than one or two rats. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days.
MICE: Open pack and place 1/4 to 1/2 oz. (1-2 level tablespoons) of bait at 8- to 12-foot intervals. Larger placements (up to 2 oz.) may be needed at points of high mice activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days.
RATS/MICE: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish as needed.
