#### STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENTS

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not plant root crops in PCNB treated fields within 12 months of broadcast and banding applications unless PCNB is registered for use on those crops.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Store product in its original container in a cool, dry, locked place out of reach of children. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned stay out of smoke.

#### GENERAL INFORMATION FOR USE ON COTTON SEED

This product is recommended as a supplement to standard seed treatment of cotton through planter box application or as a dust addition to the soil in the planting furrow. Treatment generally improves stands and promotes vigor by reducing losses due to seedling diseases caused by soil fungi such as Rhizoctonia, Pythium, Thielaviopsis and Fusarium. It may be used either by mixing directly with cotton seed in the planter box or as an infurrow treatment.

#### PLANTER BOX TREATMENT

To treat seed in Planter Box thoroughly mix 3 lbs. of dust with enough seed to plant 1 acre. Treatment is most effective for reginned and fuzzy seed, and for shallow plantings of about 1 inch in depth. Before seeding, calibrate planter to determine proper seeding rate with the mixture of seed and fungicide dust. Do not use treated seed for food, feed or oil purposes.

#### IN FURROW TREATMENT

Apply at the rate of 5 to 10 pounds of dust per acre or 1 1/2 ounces per 100 linear feet of row. Apply to the open seed furrow and to the covering soil when seed is planted, using application equipment and placement procedures such that the fungicide dust is mixed with the soil that surrounds and covers the seed. Row spacing is 38 inches.

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
