Purpose

The purpose of your submission under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is to revise your label according to PR Notice 2001-1.

Label

The label submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you make the following change submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling, including graphics, to us before you release product for shipment. A copy of the stamped label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. In your "APPLICATION DIRECTIONS" under "Rats:", add an asterisk (\*) after "bait per placement.", and include the following additional text, as in the label accepted November 6, 1995:
  - \*For the 8 oz. package, the following statement will be added: "The amount of bait in this package is unlikely to be sufficient to kill more than two to seven rats."
- 2. The following sites make this product a "Restricted Use Pesticide": river banks, gullies, irrigation ditches, garbage dumps, and landfills, railroad tracks, and along fences. During the re-registration process, you will have to add the "Restricted" text or delete these sites from this label.
- 3. Delete "in or around rat holes" as a site as it could allow the application of the product anywhere rat holes are found, which is unacceptably broad.

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Existing stocks

Stocks of existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.

Consequence for non-compliance

If these conditions are not complied with, the registrations will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

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#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**READ THIS LABEL:** Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use preçautions. **IMPORTANT:** Do not expose children, pets, or other non-target animals to rodenticides: To help to prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.

- 2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and non-target wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
- 3. Dispose of product container, and unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS: For control of Norway rats, roof rats and house mice in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings, and similar man-made structures. This product is especially suited for use in wet or damp areas, including river banks, gullies, irrigation ditches, railroad tracks, loading areas, in or around rat holes, under granaries, along fences, garbage dumps, and landfills.

Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not apply bait directly to ground surface or in grass or other ground cover. Do not broadcast bait.

Wear protective gloves when applying bait. With detergent and hot water, wash all implements used for applying bait. Do not use these implements for mixing, holding, or transferring foods or feeds.

**SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS:** Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

#### **APPLICATION DIRECTIONS**

Rats: Place 4 to 16 oz. of bait per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days

Mice: Apply 1/4 to 1/2 oz (1-2 level tablespoons) of bait at 8- to 12-foot intervals. Larger placements (up to 2 oz.) may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days.

Rats/ Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose Mice of all dead animals and leftover bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit

sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish as needed.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE**: Store only in original closed container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Store separately from fertilizer and away from products with strong odors which may contaminate the bait and reduce acceptability. Spillage should be carefully swept up and collected for disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
