Purpose The purpose of your submission under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is to revise your label according to PR Notice 2001-1.

Label The label submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you make the following change submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling, including graphics, to us before you release product for shipment. A copy of the stamped label is enclosed for your records.

1. In your "**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS**" of your "Outer Pack" under "**Rats**", add an asterisk (*) after "bait per placement.", and include the following additional text:

*For the package containing 3, 4 oz placepacks, add the following statement:
"The amount of bait in this package is unlikely to be sufficient to kill more than three to twelve rats."

2. In your "**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS**" of your 1, 4 oz placepack, add the following statement: "The amount of bait in this package is unlikely to be sufficient to kill more than one to four rats."
3. Delete the site, "in and around rat holes" as it is too vague.
4. **Note:** Some of the sites on this label (river banks, gullies, irrigation ditches, railroad tracks, garbage dumps, along fences, and landfills) qualify this product to be a "Restricted Use Pesticide".

- Label-continued** 5. Under **“PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Commercial Use:”**, consider deleting **“onsite or”** because it is too vague and could result in improper disposal.
- Existing stocks** Stocks of existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.
- Consequence for non-compliance** If these conditions are not complied with, the registrations will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ THIS LABEL: Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets, or other non-target animals to rodenticides. To help to prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and non-target wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hooved livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container, and unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS: For control of Norway rats, roof rats and house mice in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings, and similar man-made structures. This product is especially suited for use in wet or damp areas, including river banks, gullies, irrigation ditches, railroad tracks, loading areas, in or around rat holes, under granaries, along fences, garbage dumps, and landfills. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not apply bait directly to ground surface or in grass or other ground cover. Do not broadcast bait.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

- Rats:** Place one to four bait packs per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days.
- Mice:** Open Pack and apply 1/4 to 1/2 oz (1-2 level tablespoons) of bait at 8- to 12-foot intervals. Larger placements (up to 2 oz.) may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days.
- Rats/
Mice** Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store only in original closed container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Store separately from fertilizer and away from products with strong odors which may contaminate the bait and reduce acceptability. Spillage should be carefully swept up and collected for disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Commercial Use: Wastes resulting from the use of this product should be disposed of onsite or at an approved waste disposal facility.
