

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Only for formulation into Bait Products for:

(1) use in Formulating Registered End-Use products for control of Norway rats, roof rats, Polynesian rats, ground squirrels, chipmunks, muskrats, jackrabbits, cotton-tail rabbits, meadow mice, deer mice, house mouse, meadow vole, pine vole, prairie vole, pocket gopher, and mongooses. For use in Formulating Registered End-Use products for use: indoors and outdoors, in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings, and similar man-made structures, in wet or damp areas, in non-crop field uses, in forests, parks, nurseries, in dormant & non-bearing orchards (stone, pome & nuts), in rangeland, and in manual underground applications in croplands (grainfields, forage crops, hay and alfalfa crops) forests, parks and nurseries.
