DIRECTIONS

LAWNS:

ANTS: Treat Ant trails round door sills, walkways, cracks in cement walks, around garbage cans, under porches. Spot treat nest in lawns. If complete coverage of lawn is desired, 1/2 lb. per 1000 sq. ft. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed.

WHITE GRUBS: Apply at the rate of 1 1/2 to 2 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. Thoroughly wash the insecticide into the soil with ample quantities of water.

EARWIGS: Apply at the rate of 1/4 to 1/2 lb. per 1000 sq. ft. Treat damp shady areas, lawn clippings, dead or decaying vegetables and other similar hiding places.

CHINCH BUGS: Apply at the rate of 1 to 2 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. Dust entire lawn and water thoroughly after application.

MOLE CRICKETS: Dust thoroughly around base of plants at the rate of 1/2 to 1 lb. per 1000 sq. ft.

ROACHES: Outside treatment only. Spot dust infested areas such as cracks and other areas where insects have been seen running or hiding.

SOD WEBWORMS OR LAWN MOTHS: Apply to infested areas at the rate of 1/2 to 1 lb. per 1000 sq. ft. Water the lawn thoroughly before treatment.

FLOWERS:

LEAF ROLLER, CERTAIN CATERPILLARS, ANTS AND THRIPS: Dust lower and upper leaf surface when the air is still.

CUTWORMS: Attacking Camellias, Azaleas, Rhododendrons, Primroses. Dust generously around base of plants, working into top four inches of soil. Repeat as necessary.

Dust upper and lower leaf surfaces when the air is still. Apply at the rate of 10 to 20 pounds per acre, unless otherwise specified. Repeat as necessary. Do not apply to Beets after the seedling stage if the tops are to be used for food. Do not use treated Carrot tops for feed or food. Do not apply to Cabbage, Collards, Cucumbers, Melons, Squash after edible parts start to form or Tomatoes after fruit starts to form. Foliage application to Beets, Beans, Carrots, and Cole crops should not exceed 20 pounds of this material per acre. Foliage application to Potatoes should not exceed 15 pounds of this material per acre. Cucurbits should not receive more than 25 pounds per acre. All vegetable treatments are foliage treatment, do not use as soil treatment.

DO NOT APPLY: To Kale after edible parts start to form or to green or snap beans after pods start to form.
