**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Read entire label. Use in strict accordance with label directions and cautions.

**COTTON:** For early-season thrips, flea beetles and cotton fleahopper. Also for cotton leafworm and striped  
blister beetle. Apply 7 to 14 pounds of MASTER BRAND 7.5 Per Cent Dust per acre on appearance of  
insects.

For mid and late season boll weevil, bollworm, fall armyworm, cotton leaf perforator, leaf rollers, leaf-  
hoppers and tarnished plant bug. Also for light to moderate infestations of *Lygus rugus* in Western ir-  
rigated cotton. Apply 14 to 28 pounds of MASTER BRAND 7.5% Dust per acre, depending on the size  
of the cotton and insect population level. Applications for boll weevil should be made every five to  
seven days as long as control is necessary.

Aphid populations will be suppressed by repeated applications of this insecticide.  
SEVIN does not control spider mites. Where infestations are encountered, use a recommended miticide.  
SEVIN may be applied after buds open. Allow 7 days between last applications and grazing treated fields  
or harvesting crop residue for use as feed or bedding for dairy or meat animals. For protection of  
honeybees avoid unnecessary use during periods when honeybees are visiting the crop. When necessary  
to use during such periods, warn beekeepers well in advance to locate hives at a safe distance until one  
week after application.

**FORAGE GRASSES AND PASTURES:** Use 15 to 20 pounds for armyworms, sj... thrips.  
For optimum thrips control in grasses grown for seed, direct dust into boot.

**SORGHUMS (INCLUDING MILO AND GRAIN SORGHUM):** Use 15 to 30 lbs. for... corn  
earworm, stinkbugs and webworms. Use 20 pounds for sorghum midge. For optimum control on  
grain sorghum direct dust into the forming heads. Treatment for sorghum midge control should be  
made 3 to 4 days after heads have emerged from boot. Allow 21 days between last applications and  
harvest of grain sorghum.

**TOBACCO (PLANT BEGON):** For tobacco flea beetle, apply 4 to 15 lbs. per 100 square yards when  
plants appear. Repeat as needed at 10 to 14 day intervals and just before transplanting. In fields:  
Broadcast applications for hornworms and tobacco flea beetles, apply 10 to 15 pounds per acre depend-  
ing on size of the plants. Good coverage is essential. Use the highest dosage only on large plants and  
repeat as needed. Heavy applications may cause plant injury.

**NOTE**

If late applications are necessary, treat immediately after pruning.  
Some phytotoxicity may occur on tender foliage in the presence of rain or high humidity of several days  
duration following application.
