DIRECTIONS

Use sufficient dust to obtain full coverage. Apply when insects or their damage appear. Repeat at 7 to 14 day intervals or as necessary for good control. Read entire label. Use in strict accordance with label directions and cautions.

CAUTION

For protection of honey bees avoid use, if possible, during periods when honey bees are visiting the crop. When necessary to use during such periods, warn beekeepers well in advance to locate hives at a safe distance until 1 week after application.

Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not take internally. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid prolonged or repeated breathing of dust. Skin contact may be harmful. Avoid unnecessary contact. Wash hands before eating. Take shower or bath after work. Wear regular long sleeved work clothing. Change to clean clothing daily. Avoid contamination of foodstuffs.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Carbaryl is a moderate, reversible, cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

VEGETABLES

Beans: Use 10 pounds per acre for Mexican bean beetle; 20 pounds per acre for bean leaf beetle, cucumber beetles, flea beetles, leafhoppers, velvet bean caterpillar, armyworms, corn earworm, stink bugs and tarnished plant bug. This product can be applied up to the date of harvest.

Corn: Use 20 to 40 pounds per acre for corn earworm, European corn borer, fall armyworm, flea beetles and leafhoppers. For larvae in whorl (budworm damage) and foliage feeders, apply to entire plant. For insects attacking silks and ears, apply at 2 to 3 day intervals starting when first silks appear and should continue until silks begin to dry. Three or more applications may be required depending on severity of infestation. Timing and good coverage are absolutely essential for effective control. Do not apply to corn within seven days of harvest for forage.

Potato, tomato, pepper and eggplant: Use 10 to 20 pounds per acre for Colorado potato beetle, flea beetle and leafhoppers. Use 20 to 40 pounds per acre for European corn borer, fall armyworm, lace bugs, tomato fruitworm, tomato hornworm, tarnished plant bugs and stink bugs. This product can be applied up to the date of harvest.

Okra, cucumber and squash: Use 20 pounds per acre for cucumber beetles, flea beetles, leafhoppers, squash bugs, corn earworm and stink bugs. Avoid excessive applications. Some leaf injury may occur if treatments are made when tender foliage is wet or in the presence of prolonged high humidity.

POULTRY

On chickens, turkeys, ducks, partridges, pheasants and pigeons: For Northern fowl mite and lice, as a supplement to premise treatment for chicken mite and fleas: Use 1 pound per 100 birds. Apply thoroughly by means of a shaker can or hand duster. Do not apply to poultry within seven days of slaughter. Do not repeat application within four weeks. Do not contaminate food and drinking water.

Poultry Houses: For chicken mite, fleas and bedbugs: Apply 1 pound per 40 square feet of litter or floor space, and to roosts and adjacent areas by means of a hand duster or power duster. Force dust into cracks and crevices. Repeat as necessary. Do not treat nest litter. Avoid direct contamination of eggs. Do not house birds in treated houses within seven days of slaughter. Do not contaminate food and drinking water.

COTTON

For the control of boll weevil, bollworm, fall armyworm, cotton leaf worm, leaf rollers, leafhoppers, use 20-40 pounds of Master Brand 5% Sevin per acre. Timing and good coverage are absolutely essential for effective control.
