## CAUTION

### DIRECTIONS

This material is for use in the manufacturing of fertilizer only. The directions for finished product should instruct the user to apply the product at a rate sufficient to obtain the following amount of Master Brand 40% Chlordane.

For the control of the following insects attacking Lawns and Ornamental Turfs:

Ants, fire ants, harvest ants, leaf-cutting ants, earwigs: Large area apply 5 lbs. per acre. Small area apply 1/8 lb. to each 60 feet square. If possible water into the top of soil.

Chiggers, ticks: Apply to the infested area 5-10 lbs. per acre. Small area apply 1/4 lb. to each 60 feet square.

Asiatic Garden Beetle larvae, European chafer larvae, green June beetle larvae, Japanese beetle larvae, white fringed beetle larvae, white grubs, wireworms: For large areas apply 6 lbs. per acre. Small areas apply 1/4 lb. to each 2000 square feet.

If possible, work into the top of the soil.

Lawn moth and sod webworms: On large areas apply 7 lbs. per acre. Small areas apply 1/8 lb. per 900 square feet.
