

DIRECTIONS

TOMATOES: Horn Worms, Flea Beetles and Tomato Fruit Worm, early and late blight: 1/4 pound per 100 feet of row. Begin applications about the time that fruits of first clusters are well formed. Continue at 7 to 10 day intervals. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest. If seasons are favorable for late blight, treatment may be necessary as soon as plants are set in the field.

Some leaf injury may occur if treatments are made when tender foliage is wet or in the presence of prolonged high humidity.
