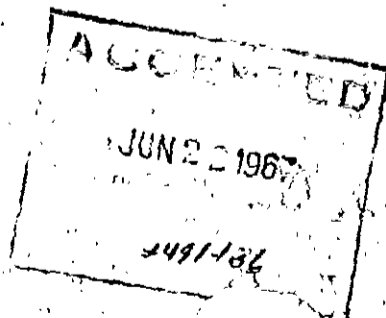

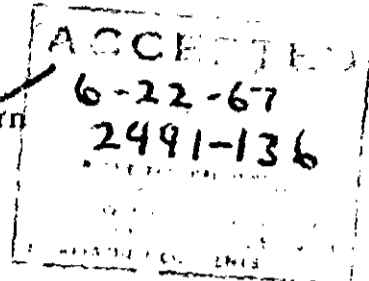

Instructions

Weeds are easiest to kill when they are young and actively growing. Dandelion Killer must stick to leaves of weeds to be effective. If foliage is not moist, sprinkle before applying.

Mow lawn before using. Do not water lawn for 24 hours after applying. If there is rain within 24 hours after application wait at least one week before second application. Do not plant lawn seed until after heavy rain and no sooner than one week after using Dandelion Killer.

Apply to new lawns only after second mowing.

Do not use on windy days. Shrubs, vegetables, and flowers can be killed by drifting.

CAUTION: Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing.
Avoid application on garden plants, flowers and shrubs.
May cause injury to bentgrass, or clover lawns
Do not store near fertilizer, seed, insecticides or fungicides.
Do not contaminate irrigation ditches or water used for domestic purposes.
