# HOLIDAY CATTLE FLY SPRAY

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To develop a residual repellency to stable flies, horn flies, mosquitoes and gnats on dairy cows, apply 1 to 2 ounces of HOLIDAY CATTLE FLY SPRAY to each animal for a three-day period. The spray should be applied with a good sprayer so that the entire animal's body has been uniformly covered. Special care should be used in spraying the legs, belly and shoulders. Avoid areas around the nose, eyes and mouth. Avoid wetting the hide. Spray in the same manner again after two days have elapsed and every second day thereafter or when insects again disturb the animals. Be sure the teats and udder are washed with warm water prior to milking. Calves should be sprayed very lightly once a day instead of attempting to build up a residual repellency by spraying more heavily.

For control of lice on dairy and beef animals, spray the animals with 2 ounces of HOLIDAY CATTLE FLY SPRAY. Immediately rub the spray into the hair, paying particular attention to infested areas. Repeat as necessary, but not more frequently than once every three weeks.

To kill flies, mosquitoes and gnats in the barn prior to milking, close all doors and windows and direct the spray toward the ceiling. The barn should remain closed for 10 to 20 minutes. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat as necessary.

To protect dairy and beef animals from attack by flies, spray bedding and walls of pen, particularly cracks and crevices. Repeat treatment frequently until adequate control is obtained. In a complete fly control program these sprays should be used in combination with residual insecticides and sanitary measures.

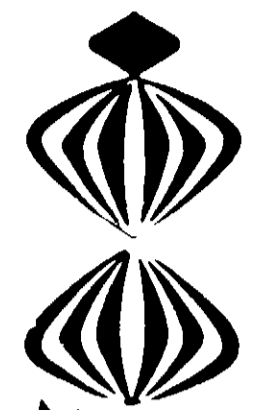

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

# HOLIDAY CATTLE FLY SPRAY

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

To keep up a continuous repellent effect, spray the animal with HOLIDAY CATTLE FLY SPRAY every three weeks. The spray should be applied with a pump sprayer so that the entire animal's body has been uniformly covered. Spray first on the legs, belly and shoulders. Avoid spraying around the face, eyes and mouth. Avoid wetting the hide. Spray in the same manner again after two days. Heavy infestations may require spraying when the animal is stabled. Rinse the face and underarms with warm water after spraying. Goggles should be worn if necessary. Do not use a fly net if attempting to build up a residual repellent by spraying more heavily.

For control of horn fly and beef animals, spray the animal with 2 ounces of HOLIDAY CATTLE FLY SPRAY immediately rub the spray into the hair, paying particular attention to the anterior areas. Repeat as necessary, but not more than once every three weeks.

To kill flies, mosquitoes and gnats in the barn, pump and swing open all doors and windows and direct the spray toward the ceiling. The barn should remain closed for 15 to 20 minutes. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat as necessary to protect dairy and beef animals from attack by fleas, spray bedding and walls of pen, particularly cracks and crevices. Repeat treatment frequently until a regular control is obtained. For a complete fly control program these sprays should be used in combination with residual insecticides and sanitary measures.
