Read all directions completely and carefully and use in comparison with directions and cautions.

DIRECTIONS

Apply dust at the rate of 1 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. For an acre use 30-40 lbs. Start using dust as soon as insects are noticed and repeat in 5 to 10 days repeating as necessary.

Rotenone kills the following insects on the plants listed which are the common targets of the insects.

Asparagus Beetles on Asparagus.

Flea Beetles, Thrips, and Twelve spotted beetles on Beans.

Cabbage Worms, Flea Beetles and Aphids on Cabbage.

Cucumber Beetles and Flea Beetles on Cucumbers.

Pea Weevils on \*Peas.

European Corn Borers on \*\*Sweet Corn.

Note: For use on \*Peas dust before the pods are set and before weevils are noticed.

For use on \*\*Sweet Corn dust when plants reach knee-high and thereafter until they are full grown by applying to whorls so the material gets down inside the whorl where the borer does his damage. Applications may be made weekly or as needed.

**CAUTION:** Wash hands after use. Do not use on vegetables within 2 days before harvesting. Destroy container when empty.

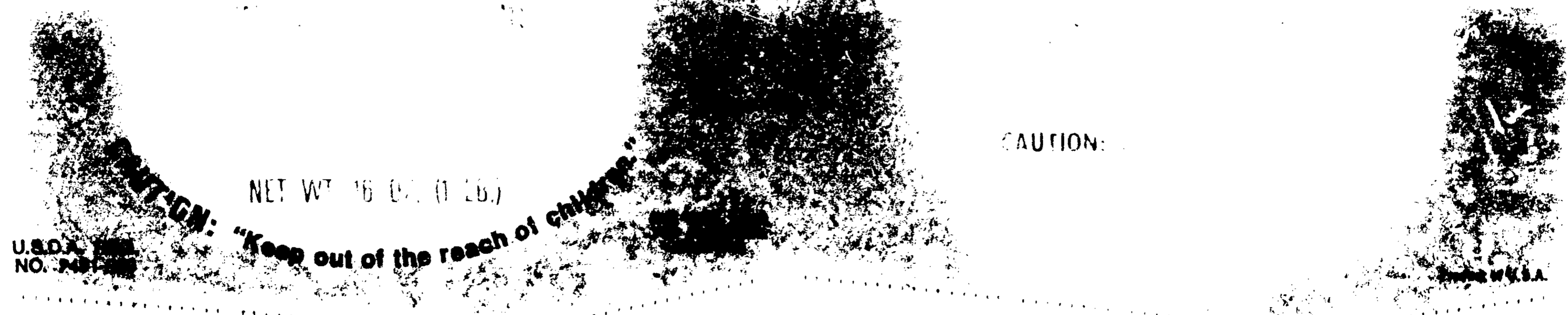
