## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**BEEF CATTLE: Lice, Ticks and Horn Flies**—Make thorough and liberal application to all parts of the animal's body by hand or power duster. Rub in lightly to carry powder beneath the hair. Repeat application at 10-14 day intervals. **DO NOT APPLY TO DAIRY CATTLE.**

**HOGS: Lice**—Make thorough and liberal application to all parts of the animal by hand or power duster as well as pen and litter. Repeat in 10 days if necessary.

**SHEEP: Lice and Keds**—Make thorough and liberal application to all parts of the animal by hand or power duster. Repeat application after 2 or 3 weeks if needed.

Do not treat animals under one month of age.

**POULTRY: Lice and Mites**—Premise Treatment—For control of chicken red mite, northern fowl mite and poultry lice, apply 1 lb. per 50 to 60 sq. ft. of litter and floor space and to nests, roosts and adjacent areas. Bird Treatment—Dust powder thoroughly into bird's feathers.

**CAUTION:** Avoid breathing of dust. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin; wash thoroughly after using. Avoid contamination of feed and water troughs. Do not reuse empty container. Destroy container when empty. Do not contaminate water by cleaning equipment or disposal of waste and containers.

Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.
