weeds* from getting started in planting
beds. May be applied to trees, shrubs
and most established flowers**. Do not
apply to Ajuga, Myrtle, Pachysandra, and
other ornamental ground-covers as in-
jury may result.

Apply anytime after flowers and plants
are well established, at least 2-3 inches
high. For best results, follow these
directions carefully:

1. Before applying, remove all existing
broadleaf and grassy weeds since this
product only kills sprouting seeds, not
established weeds.
2. Spread **FLOR-ADORN** evenly. Avoid
missing small areas since weeds will
grow in spots not covered. Working
product into soil lightly gives maxi-
mum weed control and fertilizer ac-
tivity.
3. Contents of this package covers 200
sq. ft. of soil area. A second applica-
tion in 6 weeks will assure continued
weed control.
4. After application, sprinkle plants and
shrubs lightly with water to remove
any of the product from foliage.
