Apply Nature's Best Brand Lawn Insecticide uniformly to home lawns and other ornamental and recreational turf grass areas using any hand or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Treat when insects first appear using Nature's Best Brand Lawn Insecticide at the rate of 200 pounds per acre. To help obtain uniform distribution, apply one-half the required amount of product in one direction: then apply the balance at a right angle. For best results, immediately after application sprinkle the turf with 1300 gallons of water per acre so as to wash the granules into the zone of insect infestation. Consult the following table to determine amounts of Nature's Best Brand Lawn Insecticide and water needed for smaller sized area. Re-treat as necessary.

GRUBS: To Control Certain White Grubs (Larvae of European chafer and Japaness beetle) use two to four times the amounts of Nature's Best Brand Lawn Insecticide shows in the table, i.e. 10 to 20 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. Apply the granules uniformly over the area treated. For best results, immediately water to wash the insecticide into the

turf. For best results treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface, usually during late July and August. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for proper time to treat in your area.

FOR CONTROL OF FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Thoroughly apply this product as a spot treatment to infested areas such as:

Yard Areas: Apply this product uniformly to home lawns, under shrubbery, and other ornamental recreational turf grass areas. Treat when insects first appear using at the rate of one pound per 200 sq. ft. or 4 pounds per 800 sq. ft. To help obtain distribution, apply one-half required amount of product in one direction, then apply the balance at a right angle. Immediately after application, sprinkle the turf with 40 gallons of water per 800 sq. ft. so as to wash the granules into the zone of insect infestation. Retreat as necessary.

Pet Beds: Old bedding of pests should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Do not apply this product indoors. DO NOT TREAT PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT. To control the source of your flea infestation, treat pets with an EPA approved product registered for direct application to pets.

FOR FIRE ANT MOUNDS: To control fire ants apply 4 ounces to each mound. After application of granules, gently sprinkle the treated area with minimum of 1 quart water per 6 inches of mound diameter. For best results apply in cool weather (65-80°F) or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear.

HYPERODES: To Control Hyperodes (turfgrass) weevils use at the rate of 10 lbs. per 1000 square feet. Treat suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for best time to treat in your area.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container and keep any bags containing unused product in an area inaccessible to children and domestic animals. Do not store near feed or foodstuff. To prevent cross-contamination, do not store near other fertilizers, or near herbicides, insecticides, fungicide: or seeds. PRODUCT DISPOSAL: To dispose of bags which contain unused product, securely wrap bag in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty bag.
