

leave birds in cage; but remove all food, water and foodstuffs. Using
quick, short strokes, spray directly on birds from a distance of
12 to 18 inches.

Do not spray into the eyes or face of pet.

For cage mite control, remove birds plus food and water. Clean cage
thoroughly in hot water and repeat at least once weekly. After cleaning,
spray cage from 12 inches with 5 or 6 pump actions.

Don't spray bird on cage more than twice weekly to continue control of
lice and mites. Replace overcap after use.
