If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL. Remove overcap. To control bird, lice, leave birds in cage, but remove all food, water, and foodstuffs. Using quick, short strokes, spray directly on birds from a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Do not spray into the eyes or face of pet. For cage mite control, remove birds plus food and water. Clean cage thoroughly in hot water and repeat at least once weekly. After cleaning, spray cage from 12 inches with 5 or 6 pump actions. Do not spray bird or cage more than twice weekly to continue control of lice and mites. Replace overcap after use.
