**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Store in cool dry place. Do not use or refill with open flame. Dispose of empty container by replacing cap and recycling.

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**CAUTION:** Do not spray into eyes. Avoid breathing of spray and avoid contact with human skin. Wash hands after using. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Contains a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is an antidote. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of treated area. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Do not use on dogs less than 6 weeks old.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF ON SKIN:** Wash with plenty of soap and water.


**IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

**PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.
