Subject: Revised Labeling & Confidential Statement of Formula
(Change Active to Inert)
Sarcoptic Mange Medicine
EPA Registration No. 2517-41
Your Applications Dated May 15, 1989 and June 22, 1990

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, will be acceptable provided the following changes/information are made:

1. Delete the term "Medicine" from the product name since it is misleading in implying that the product has drug-like qualities. The product as labeled (for control of sarcoptic mange) is regulated solely by EPA.

We agree that the previously declared active ingredients (paraffin base oil, kerosene, petroleum crude oil, and oil of pine tar) are in fact inactive and have no pesticidal or drug (medicinal) qualities. Thus, they may be removed from the active ingredient statement and included in the total percentage of inerts.

2. You must provide the following product chemistry information.
 - a. On the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF), you must provide the density and flashpoint of the product.

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- b. Based on the current CSF dated January 7, 1986, column 13.b. does not agree with the inert ingredient statement on the label. Column 13.b. (Neutral Oil) should be 24.94%. Please revise the label or the CSF so the information agrees.
3. Add a footnote to the label ingredient statement indicating:

Contains Petroleum Distillates.
4. Submit five (5) copies of the revised finished complete labeling, showing your Company Name and Logo.
