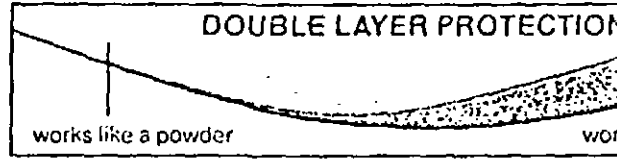

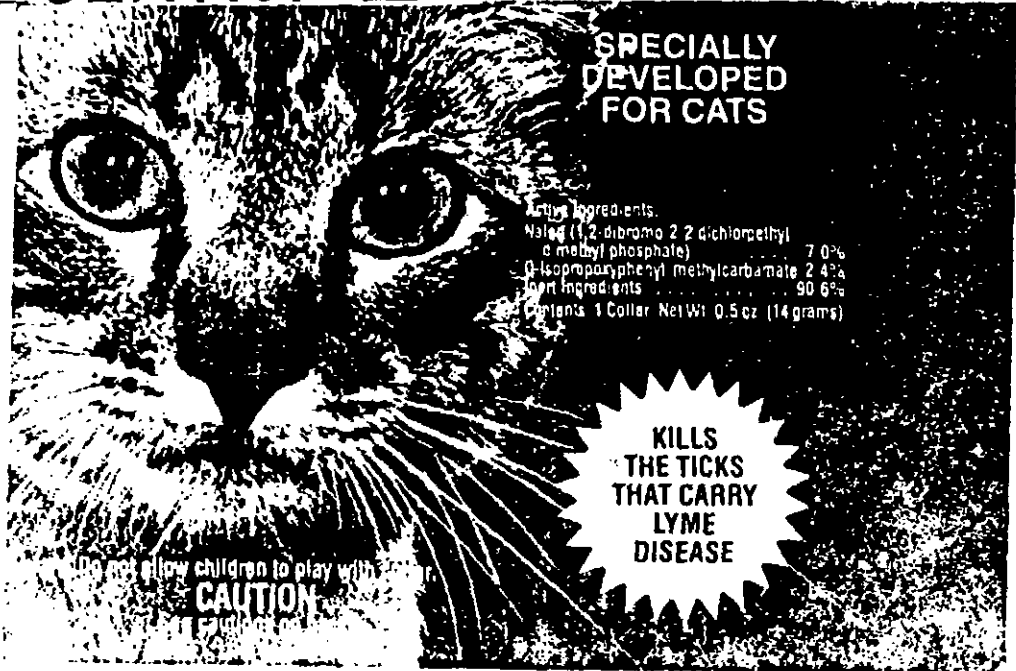

Place Collar around cat's neck, adjust for fit, and buckle in place. The Collar must be worn continuously to permit the Collar to move about the neck. Generally, a proper fit, when fastened, will snugly slide over cat's head. Leave 2 or 3 inches for extra length. Dispose of excess length. Wash hands after installing Collar on cat. Under normal conditions, replace when effectiveness diminishes every 5 months.

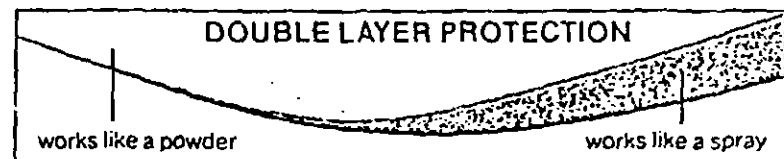

Some animals may become irritated by any Collar. If this occurs, remove Collar. If condition persists, consult a veterinarian. Do not use on kittens under 3 months of age.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Place Collar around cat's neck, adjust for fit, and buckle in place. The Collar must be worn loosely to allow for growth of the cat and to permit the Collar to move about the neck. Generally, a properly fitted Collar is one that, when fastened, will snugly slide over cat's head. Leave 2 or 3 inches for extra adjustment. Cut off and dispose of excess length. Wash hands after installing Collar on cat. Under normal conditions, replace Collar every 5 months. With severe infestations, replace when effectiveness diminishes.

Store unopened Collar in a cool, dry place. Dispose of empty pouch and expired Collar in trash.

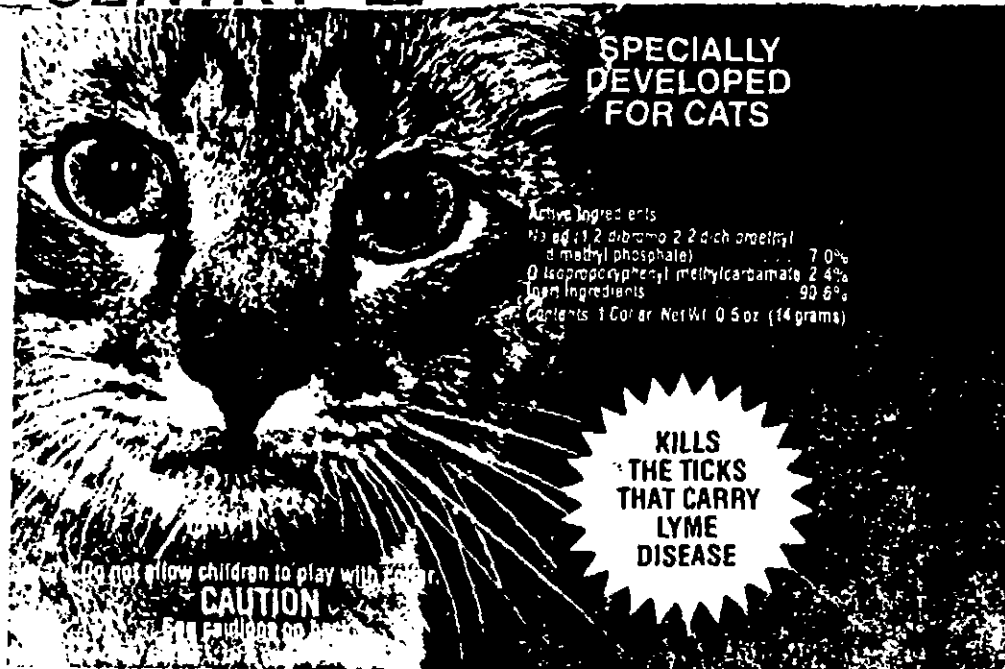
