Make the following changes to your labels:

- 1) Insert the signal word, CAUTION, immediately prior to the the precautionary paragraph on the back panel.
- 2) Eliminate from the ingredient statement the phrase "(Contains petroleum distillates 0.486%)".

Please make certain that all signal words and warning statements are of the proper size, as prescribed in ⁴⁰CFR 156.10.

DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Wet dog's coat thoroughly. Starting at the head and working back, pump soap on dog. Rub until dog's entire body is covered with lather. Be sure that lather is worked thoroughly into dog's coat down to the skin. Soap should remain on animal 10 minutes, then rinse completely and towel dry. Keep away from eyes. Repeat as necessary.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:
IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water.
IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.
