The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Reinstate the restriction "Do not use on nursing puppies or puppies under 6 weeks".
2. At next printing of the label, delete "Get medical attention" following the statement of practical treatment for skin contact.
3. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

Fast-Breaking Foam For Dogs

IMPORTANT CONSUMER INFORMATION

PURPOSE: Sergeant's® fast-breaking foam is specially formulated to kill fleas, ticks and lice. The foam will break quickly and disappear into the dog's coat. One application keeps working to kill newly-acquired fleas for up to 14 days. To kill ticks repeat every 7 days. This pleasantly scented product is a lovingly quiet foam that will not frighten your dog.

DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake before using. Hold can upright about one inch from dog's back. Press activator to release foam. Start at the back of head and move nozzle slowly so that a line of foam will be deposited along the dog's back from head to tail. Apply foam at the rate of 4 seconds for each 10 pounds of your pet's weight.

Use this chart as a guide.

If Your Dog Weighs	Apply The Foam For
10 lbs	4 seconds
15 lbs	6 seconds
20 lbs	8 seconds

Apply again in 14 days.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store only in cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Do not reuse empty container. When empty, replace cap, securely wrap in newspaper, and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Do not inhale product. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Do not use on nursing puppies under 6 weeks.

Practical Treatment

IF IN EYES, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF SWALLOWED, call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with fingers. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN, wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED, remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause boiling.
