4. Add the statement "Ticks will die in 24-48 hours" to the label of this product.

IMPORTANT CONSUMER INFORMATION

PURPOSE: Sergeant's® Flea and Tick Killing Foam is specially formulated to kill fleas and ticks on cats. This foam will break quickly and disappear into the cat's coat. One application keeps working to kill newly acquired fleas for up to 14 days. To kill ticks, repeat every 7 days. This pleasantly scented product is a lowlygry quiet foam that will not frighten your cat.

DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake Well Before Using. With cat standing, apply a line of Sergeant's Flea and Tick Killing Foam slowly along the back starting from the tail and ending at the neck. Hold the nozzle as close to the skin as possible (parting the hair of long haired cats) for maximum effectiveness.

This foam will dissolve down to skin level and automatically spread out and down the sides of your cat to provide effective protection where your cat needs it most. Apply foam at the rate of 2 seconds for each 5 pounds of your pet's weight.

Use this chart as a guide.

If Your Cat Weighs	Apply The Foam For
5 lbs	2 seconds
10 lbs	4 seconds
15 lbs	6 seconds

Apply again in 14 days.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store only in cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Do not reuse empty container. When empty, replace cap, securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Do not inhale product. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Do not use on nursing kittens or kittens under 3 months of age.

Practical Treatment

IF IN EYES: immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF SWALLOWED: call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with fingers. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN: wash with plenty of soap and water.

IF INHALED: remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.


