- f. Revise the heading "Directions" to "Directions for Use."

3. Based on review of your Efficacy Data the following label claims are supported. You must revise claims already present on your label as needed:

- a. Kills and repels fleas and ticks on dogs and cats.
- b. Kills fleas up to 17 days and ticks for 3 weeks.
- c. Repels fleas and ticks for 5 days.
- d. Kills the ticks that may carry Lyme disease.
- e. Long-lasting protection, protects against fleas up to 17 days and against ticks up to 24 days.

4. The Precautionary Review Section has classified your acceptable acute toxicity studies as core guideline. The following toxicology categories have been assigned:

PURPOSE:

SERGEANT'S FLEA & TICK DIP provides long-lasting protection against fleas and ticks for both dogs and cats. This water-based formula will completely coat the pet's fur effectively killing fleas and ticks for up to 24 days. This product is ideal for treating heavy infestations of fleas and ticks. Look for Sergeant's flea & tick products for the home and yard to further protect the pet's environment.

DIRECTIONS:

THIS PRODUCT IS CONCENTRATED AND MUST BE DILUTED BEFORE USE. SHAKE BOTTLE WELL BEFORE USING. Stir one-half cup (4 fl. oz.) of SERGEANT'S FLEA & TICK DIP into one gallon of water. Mix or stir product thoroughly before applying diluted emulsion to pet. Dip, sponge, or swab pet with emulsion until thoroughly wet. Allow pet to dry in a warm place without rinsing or toweling. Repeat applications at intervals of two to three weeks as required.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in cool, dry place. To dispose of empty container, replace cap, wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not reuse empty bottle.
