[Applied as a dip]

PURPOSE: Sergeant's Multipurpose Flea & Tick Killer I is specially formulated to provide long-lasting protection against fleas & ticks. This water-based formula will completely coat your dogs fur effectively controlling fleas & ticks for up to 14 days.

[Applied as a household {premise} spray]

PURPOSE: Sergeant's Multipurpose Flea & Tick Killer I is specially formulated for long lasting control of fleas & ticks where your pet sleeps and plays. This ready to use household spray is ideal for spot treatment of a wide variety of household insects. {listed below}

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment.

[To control fleas and ticks on dogs for 14 days]

Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animals entire body is treated, including the legs and underbody. Fluff the hair while spraying so that the spray will penetrate to the skin and thoroughly wet it. Do not spray into eyes or face. Avoid contact with genitalia. Reapply every 14 days.

[Applied as a dip]

Wet the dog with water before treatment. Sponge or pour Sergeant's Multipurpose Flea & Tick Killer I on the dog until its fur and skin are thoroughly wet, making sure that the animal's entire body is treated, including the legs and underbody. Do not treat the dog's face. Avoid contact with genitalia. Reapply every 14 days.

[Applied as a household {premise} spray]

Apply as a direct spray to control accessible stages of crawling insects including, but not limited to, fleas, ticks cockroaches, ants, spiders, silverfish and crickets. Spray to lightly dampen absorbent surfaces and wet non-absorbent

surfaces but do not allow runoff to occur. Thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds and resting quarters. Fresh bedding should be placed in the animals quarters after treatment. Direct spray into cracks and crevices, along baseboards, moldings and window and door frames as well as localized areas of floor and floor covering. Repeat as necessary.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Harmful if inhaled. Causes eye injury. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist.
