2. Make the labeling change listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- b. Add the following to the beginning of Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals:

"Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. . ."

- c. Revise you Statement of Practical Treatment as follows:

IF SWALLOWED: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything to an unconscious person.

- d. The statement "It is also quieter than normal aerosol sprays and, therefore, less frightening to your pet" is unacceptable and must be deleted. You may submit comparison data supporting the claim by demonstrating that your product is quieter than normal sprays.

3. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

IMPORTANT CONSUMER INFORMATION

PURPOSE: SERGEANT'S FLEA AND TICK SPRAY is specially formulated to kill fleas on your pet for up to 14 days, and will kill ticks for 4 days (DOGS), 9 days (CATS). (The product may be sprayed from any angle for ease of application - even upside down! It is also quieter than normal aerosol sprays and, therefore, less frightening to your pet.)

DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL. Remove cap; from a distance of approximately 8 - 12 inches spray pet against the lay of the coat, fluffing long hair so mist reaches pet's skin (include the legs and underbody but avoid the face, eyes, and genitalia). The spray should wet ticks thoroughly. (For Cats) Apply at a rate of 1 second per pound of body weight. (For Dogs) Apply at a rate of 2 seconds per pound of body weight for thin or short-haired dogs and up to 8 seconds per pound of body weight for heavy or long-haired dogs. Repeat as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame. Replace cap, securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Do not spray pet's face, eyes, or genitalia. Do not use on nursing puppies or kittens or animals under 3 months of age. Do not use this or any other pesticide on sick, old, or debilitated animals.
