[The product may be sprayed from any angle for ease of application – even upside down! It is also quieter than normal aerosol sprays and, therefore, less frightening to your pet].**

DIRECTION FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner that is inconsistent with its labeling. SHAKE WELL. Remove cap; from a distance of approximately 8-12 inches spray pet against the lay of the coat, fluffing long hair so mist reaches pet's skin (include the legs and underbody but avoid the face, eyes, and genitalia). The spray should wet ticks thoroughly. [For cats] Apply at a rate of 1 second per pound of body weight. [For Dogs] Apply at a rate of 2 seconds per pound of body weight for thin or short-haired dogs and up to 8 seconds per pound of body weight for heavy or long-haired dogs. Reapply every week.
