PURPOSE: Sergeant's Flea & Tick Spray is specially formulated to kill fleas on your pet for up to 14 days and will kill ticks for (4 days on dogs) (9 days on cats). [The product may be sprayed from any angle for ease of application – even upside down! It is also quieter than normal aerosol sprays and therefore, less frightening to your pet].**

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL. Remove cap; from a distance of approximately 8-12 inches and starting at the tail, spray pet against the lay of the coat, moving the dispenser rapidly, fluffing long hair so spray penetrates to the pet's skin (include the legs and underbody but avoid the face, eyes and genitalia). The spray should wet ticks thoroughly. For cats, apply at a rate of 1 second per pound of body weight. For dogs, apply at a rate of 2 seconds per pound of body weight for heavy or long-haired dogs. Reapply every week.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards To Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not spray pets face, eyes, or genitalia. Do not use on nursing puppies or animals under 12 weeks.
